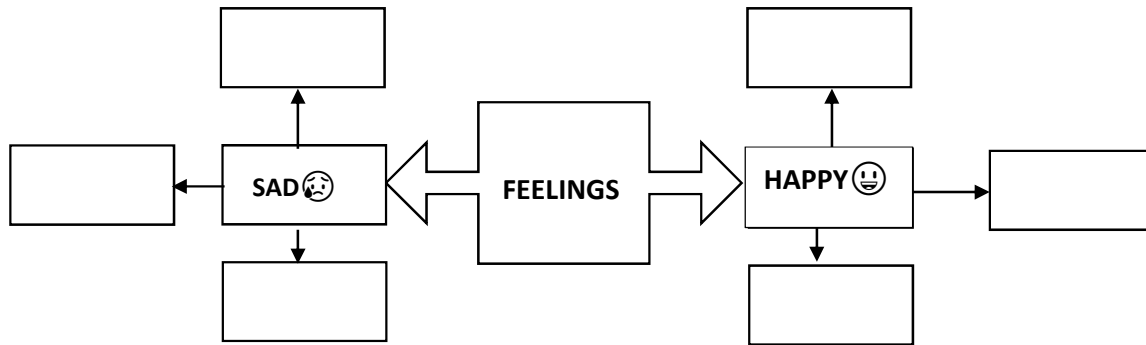

## WRITING

### DIARY ENTRY

- A diary is a record of personal events. We record important and significant days and with it our personal feelings. Thus, it is a personal document. We stress on feelings, emotions, reactions rather than on the event itself and use conversational and friendly language. Every diary writing includes some general **entries which are given below-**

#### **Date, Day & Time:**

Diary Writing is a memory. Before writing an entry, mention the date, day, and time so that you know when that particular incident/event took place if you read it later in the future. Usually, date, day, and time should be mentioned in the top left corner.

**Content:** Make an entry about your experience, event, or feelings. The style and tone can be informal. Express anything and everything which you would like to tell to your diary. A diary entry is personalized so, write it is always written in the first person. At times you may leave out the pronoun “I” for example- “Am really excited”, “Went to the beach today.” Do not write a very long entry.

**Signature:** Diary Entry is a personal thing. So, it is optional if you would like to give a signature or write your name after an entry.

### FORMAT OF DIARY ENTRY

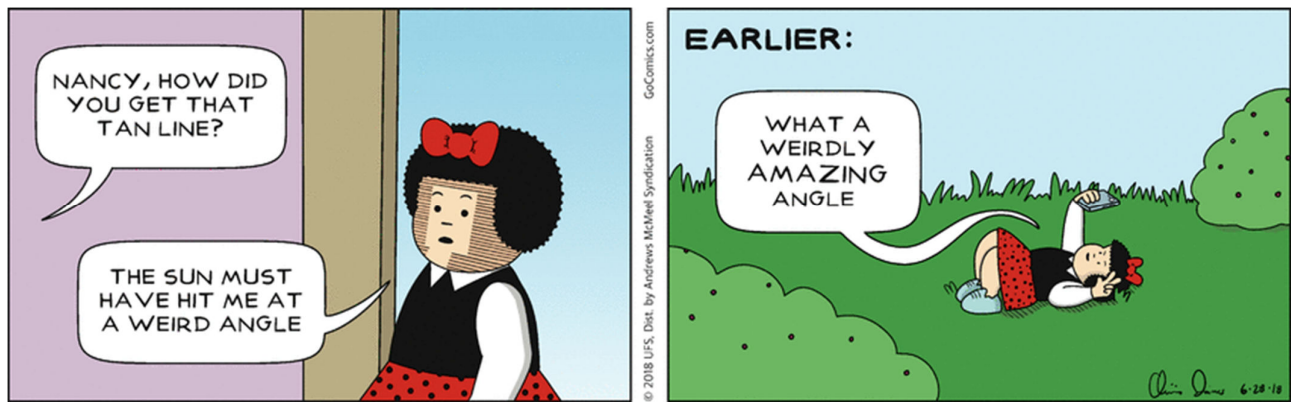
## The amazing world of cartoons.....

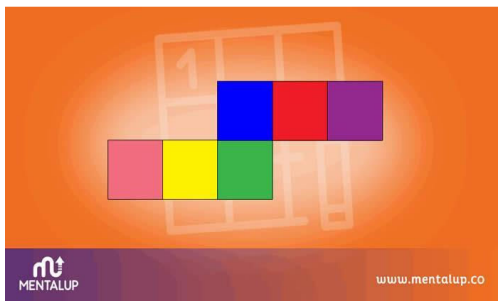

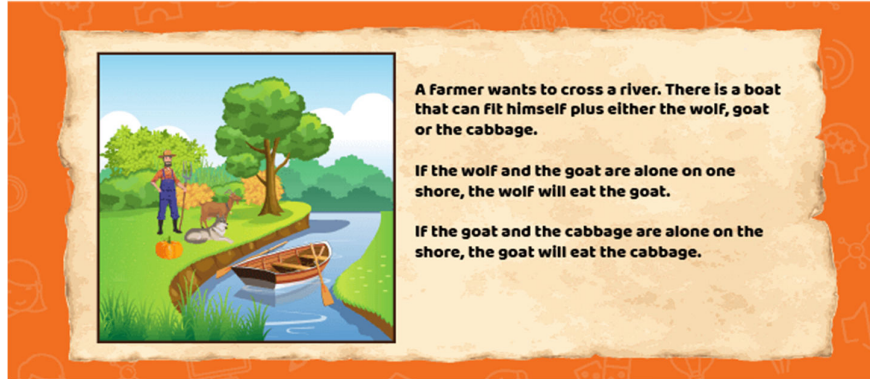


